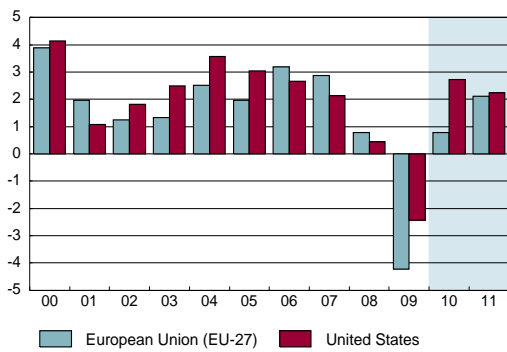

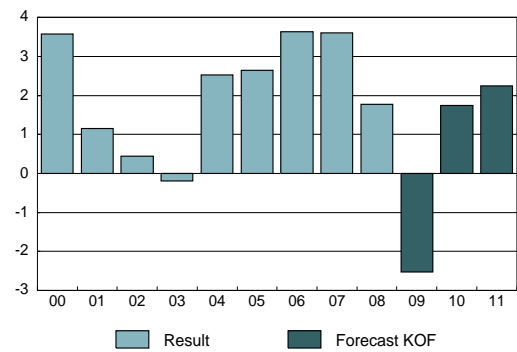

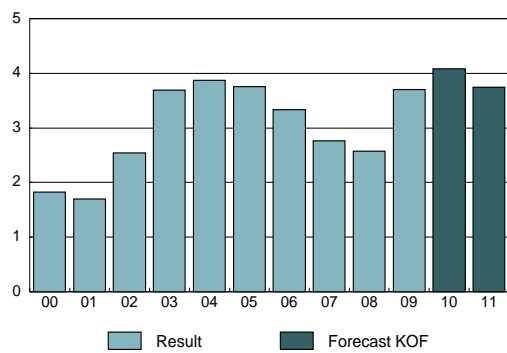
Graph 1
